

OHIO TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES

November 11, 2019

The trustees met in regular session with all Mr. Hinson and Mr. Vogelsang present. The board currently has a vacancy.

Also present were Chief Craig Light, PTFD, Larry Bramlage, Marty Waldeck, Kathy Waldeck, Kathy Ireton, Cindy Cassell, Emily Niehaus, Don Adams, Emily Supinger and Les Smith.

The meeting was called to order at 6:30pm by Mr. Hinson.

Mr. Hinson made a motion to accept the minutes of the October 14, 2019 regular meeting, seconded by Mr. Vogelsang. Both members voted "yea"

Mr. Hinson made a motion to accept the minutes of the October 28, 2019 special meeting, seconded by Mr. Vogelsang. Both members voted "yea"

Mr. Hinson thanked all veterans for their service.

Chief Wright, PTFD, gave his report (on file). Reported that the storm sirens in the southern portion of the county did not activate during the monthly test. They should be operational now. Mr. Vogelsang asked how the new squad is working out. Chief Wright noted that it has a water leak somewhere around the windshield and they are getting used to using it.

Cpl. Feilhauer, CCSO: Absent, no report. Mr. Hinson reported one overdose, no burglaries or break-ins in the past month.

Les Smith gave his zoning report (on file). Reported that Larry Williams has yet to appear in court and efforts continue to get him to clean up his property.

Dave O'Connor maintenance report: Absent, written report submitted read aloud by Mr. Hinson.

OLD BUSINESS: None

COMMUNICATIONS: A letter received from the department of liquor control regarding a permit application for the new Dollar General store was reviewed; a letter from NRAC district 10 looking for committee seat nominations was also reviewed with no action taken.

Mr. Hinson made a motion not to request a hearing for the Dollar General store liquor permit application, seconded by Mr. Vogelsang. Both members voted "yea"

NEW BUSINESS:

Trustee Vacancy: Bill Gilpin reported receiving 7 applications for the trustee vacancy. The applicants are Larry Bramlage, Kathy Ireton, Emily Niehaus, Karla Painter, Frank Renn, Susan Stark and Kathy Waldeck. There was discussion on the need to schedule a special meeting for interviews and naming a new trustee.

Mr. Hinson made a motion schedule a special meeting on November 19 at 4pm to interview candidates for the vacant trustee seat and to name a new trustee, seconded by Mr. Vogelsang. Both members voted "yea"

Mr. Vogelsang reported that while campaigning he spoke with several people who are also recovering from strokes and expressed interest in creating a support group.

Cindy Cassell asked about the NRAC letter. Mr. Hinson explained that it is a committee looking for nominations for committee seats.

Les Smith reported that Cindy Cassell has applied to be an alternate on the board of zoning appeals.

Mr. Vogelsang made a motion to appoint Cindy Cassell as alternate to the board of zoning appeals for a term expiring March 2022, seconded by Mr. Hinson. Both members voted "yea"

Fund balances were discussed.
